Analytical Chemistry and the Chemical and Biological Microsystems Society are seeking nominations for the 2017 Young Innovator Award. The award honors the contributions of an individual who has demonstrated exceptional technical advancement and innovation in the field of micro- or nanofluidics in his or her early career.

The award will be presented at μ TAS (MicroTAS) 2017 in Savannah Georgia, October 22 -26, 2016.

Nomination Eligibility:

- Doctorate must have been earned in the past 15 years
- Self-nominations are allowed

Nomination Requirements:

Nominators should send the CV of the nominee and a nomination letter including:

- Alma mater and graduation date of the nominee
- Description of the nominee's accomplishments (one page maximum)
- Citation of a specific technical achievement (to be printed on the award plaque)
- List of key publication(s) relevant to the nomination
- May also include up to two seconding letters (two page maximum)

Nominations are carried over for two additional years. Nominee is expected to be present at the meeting at which the award is presented. The winner will receive:

- An award plaque
- \$2,500 USD honorarium
- Up to \$1,500 in travel expenses to μ TAS (MicroTAS) 2017 in Savannah, Georgia, October 22 - 26, 2017
