Recognizing significant contributions by emerging authors in microfluidics and nanofluidics

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this annual award, the candidate must:

- 1 Have published a paper to *Biomicrofluidics* between January 1 and December 31.
- 2 Be 40 years of age or younger.
- 3 Be the first author on the selected paper.

Selection Process

Papers will be reviewed based on scientific content. The winner will be chosen by an expert panel of judges. The winner will be notified of their award via email by March 31.

The Prize

The winner of the *Biomicrofluidics* Best Paper Award will be granted a cash prize of \$2500 USD.*
